The Texas Projection Measure (TPM) is a measure of a student's future projected growth. The high school TPM estimate is likely to pass the 11th Grade TAKS test based on the student's current TAKS performance and the school's previous average TAKS scores. A high TPM score shows that the school is adding value for the student's education.

A **horizontal change** compares the same grade level from one year to the next such as comparing this year's 9th grade performance with last year's 9th grade performance.

A **vertical change** compares one grade level's performance with the same student group's performance the previous year such as comparing this year's 10th graders with last year's 9th graders.
