

NHS Important Information:

When are the NHS meetings?

The 1st and 3rd Tuesday of every month at 7:45am in N119 & 3:45pm usually in the cafeteria. If you come to the morning meetings you can get an early hall pass for the whole year.

How many hours am I required to do a semester?

6 hours with NHS & 6 hours outside of NHS for a total of 12 hours per semester.

Where do I find information on service projects?

Outside of room N215 and N119, in the NHS glass case located on the second floor across from the main office, or by listening to LCT. Other basic information about NHS is available on the PTO website and the Lamar website. Service project announcements are also made at meetings.

Where do I get an Hour Log Sheet?

Outside of room N215 or N119 or you can download one from the PTO website or the Lamar website

What should I do if I miss a meeting?

Pick up an Agenda outside of room N215 or N119 and ask a friend about any important information you might have missed.

How much are my dues and when do I pay them?

Dues are \$ 10 each year and are due the first meeting in September 2009. Not paying dues can make you lose your NHS eligibility. If need assistance, see Mrs. Dolch or Ms. Gaido.

Who should I talk to about any problems I am having attending meetings, getting service hours, etc.?

Talk to the sponsors or your officers immediately. Failure to complete your semester hours will result in being put on suspended status. If you still do not fulfill your hours by the deadline for delinquent hours which is in March of the spring semester, you will be asked to leave NHS.

What do I have this May? Do I need to do any hours before the end of school?

No, your NHS requirements begin in the Fall of 2009; you will need twelve hours by the end of the fall semester.
