

Students may wear Halloween costumes to school on Thursday, October 29, 2009. All costumes must adhere to the following conditions:

You must be able to sit, walk, breathe, see and hear! (no masks that cover the face)

Costumes should not include blood, gore, or violence.

No pretend "prop" weapons such as water pistols, knives or swords!

No provocative attire is to be worn

All school rules will be enforced (no bikes or skateboards, etc.)

Costumes may not be offensive or inappropriate in any way

Students must wear shoes. Sandals are permissible. House/bedroom slippers and flip flops are not permitted. Heels must be less than two inches as measured from the rear of the base of the shoe to the floor.

Accessories/clothing which constitute a safety hazard to self and/or others are unacceptable.

The length of shorts, skorts, skirts and dresses must be to the knee. Spandex or body hugging shorts and tights are restricted to the physical education or work out area, unless covered by outer clothing.

All clothing must cover entire mid-riff area when standing, walking, or sitting. Low cut revealing tops are not allowed. Shirts without sleeves are not permitted. Tank tops, transparent clothing, and clothing designed to be worn as an undergarments are not permitted.

All clothing and accessories must be free of profane, suggestive or provocative language and/or symbols, advertisement or promotion of alcohol, tobacco, or drug use, and/or reference to or association with gang activity.

Undergarments are required and should not be visible.

Pants and shorts must be worn at the waist. Clothing must be size appropriate. All pajama tops and bottoms, sleepwear, or clothing that is designed as beachwear are not allowed.
