

# **G.C. Scarborough High School Uniform Policy 2009-2010**

Shirts - Shirts must be **black or white polo-style**. All shirts must have sleeves, be buttoned and properly fitted. Any logo present on shirts must be smaller than 2 inches and cannot make reference to violence, sex, drugs, guns/weapons, gangs, profanity, or foreign symbols. All shirts must be tucked in at all times. NO bare midriffs may be showing at any time. \*No undergarment should be visible. Any undergarment T-shirt must be white.

Sweaters, Sweatshirts, & Jackets - All sweaters and sweatshirts must be solid black. Approved Scarborough sweatshirts are allowed. Jackets must be **solid black**. Logos are not allowed anywhere on jackets. All jackets must be shorter than knee length. Scarborough letterman jackets are permitted.

Pants & Skirts - Pants must be **plain khaki (beige) school uniform** pants (no Dickies brand, cargo pants or any other pants that have a drop-crotch). Rips, tears or holes are not permitted. All pants must be fitted at the waist and reach the bottom of the ankles. Belts must be solid black, white, or brown. \*Shorts, capris, sweat-pants, and pajama pants are not permitted.\* Skirts must be solid, khaki (beige). All skirts must be worn at the waist and extend below the knee. No skirts may have a slit that extends above the knee.

Footwear - All shoes must be worn properly. Shoelaces must be in one of the approved standardized dress code colors. No house shoes, slippers, flip-flops, or sandals are permitted. Heels should not be higher than 2 inches.

Jewelry & Eyewear - Jewelry (including body jewelry) must not contain spikes. Jewelry should not be heavy, harmful or distracting. Sunglasses are not to be worn in the building. Only prescription contacts are permitted.

Head Gear - No head coverings of any kind are permitted in the building. This includes (but is not limited to) caps, hats, bandanas, wave caps, do rags, sweatbands, towels, etc. Combs, picks, etc. are not to be worn in the hair or on the head. \*Bandanas are not allowed on campus.\* (All items are subject to confiscation).

ID Badges - All students are required to wear their own Scarborough High School ID badges above their waist with their picture visible at all times. Note: ID badges are property of HISD.

Backpacks and Bags - Student backpacks, bags, and purses may be searched at any time. Scarborough athletes may not carry their athletic bags to class: (leave bags in the gym or field house).

Students not in compliance with the standardized dress code will be subject to disciplinary action (SRC or suspension) and will not be allowed to attend class. The administration of Scarborough High School will be the final authority of any rules subject to interpretation. When in doubt, do not wear items until it has been cleared by an administrator.
