Football Outlook 2009: Booker T. Washington **War Eagles**

The Booker T. Washington War Eagles are coming off a 2-7 (2-5 in district) season record starting a large group of underclassmen. The Eagles are losing some key players in Dominique Adams (Sul Ross), James Holloway (Southern). The War Eagles are looking to rebound in 2009 behind the play of their returning underclassmen. Coach Taplin-McMillan, in his second year at the helm looks to build upon the foundation that was laid during his first campaign relying upon his senior class to lead the way.

On the offensive side of the ball, the War Eagles return nine starts from last year's squad. Among the leaders on are running back Charles Cooper district 22-4A's newcomer of the year (500 yards rushing in district play); joining Cooper in the back field will be Brandon Jones and Caleb Reynolds. Wynton Perrot returns at quarterback, and will have a host of returning receivers to haul in his passes. Perrot will look to William Waddel, Allen McCord, Ketrick McCutcheon, and Jones to make plays in the passing game. The offensive line will be returning three year starter Sharron Tillman to lead a group that returns Jamarcus Lawrence, and Alexander Brown.

The defense for the War Eagles will be anchored by a group of senior linebackers leading the way. Seniors Detrane Lindsey, Paul Jordan, Keeland Bryant, and Carmichael Gray will be looked upon to provide leadership to an otherwise inexperienced group on defense. The defensive line will look to Chancellor Lee returning from a year on offense to add some experience to a talented, but inexperienced group that includes junior Jalen Randle. The secondary will have to lean on the play of returning safeties Anthony Comeaux and Cameron Leonard. The War Eagles special teams really have a chance to be a weapon with first team all-district kicker Ivan Lopez and punter Wayne Ardoin back in the fold. The War Eagles commitment to hard work and a proper attitude have positioned them to return to championship football.
