Thank you for your interest in Westside High school's Entrepreneur 101 program. The E-101 program is a three year program designed to give students the most authentic culinary arts and restaurant management experience possible and is one of very few in the state of Texas!

Our rigorous curriculum, paired with a commercial kitchen and Outback Steakhouse branded dining room will give your child a hands-on look into the world of culinary arts and entrepreneurship. Your student will enter the program as a sophomore and continue through the remainder of high school. The first year of the program allows your child to learn the fundamentals of cooking, sanitation, and some basic business skills. Through classroom lessons and hands-on cooking labs, students will learn everything from basic knife skills to the art of grilling, converting recipes, and much more! The second year of the program takes what your child has learned and put it to practical use in our student run restaurant.
