Report Cards – Final report cards will be issued at WHS on Friday, June 1, 2007 from 9:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M.

Locker Cleanout - Locker Cleanout will be held on Thursday, May 17, 2007 at the end of the school day. All trash should be removed. All locks must be removed and taken home. Lockers will be permanently closed and students will not be permitted to use lockers after this time.

Title 1 Summer School – All students enrolled at Worthing High School for the 2006 -2007 school year will have the opportunity to attend FREE Summer School to regain credit in up to three core classes (math, science, social studies, and/or science) that they did not pass this school year. Registration for Summer School will begin on May 31, 2007 and will end June 6, 2007. Title 1 Summer School will begin on Thursday, June 4, 2007 and will end on Friday, June 29, 2007. Classes are one hour and forty-five minutes in length. Classes will begin promptly at 8:00 a.m. and will end at 2:15 p.m. This is a great opportunity for students to recapture credit and stay on target for graduation. To enroll students must submit a completed counselor approval form to their grade level counselor by Tuesday, June 5, 2007. Remember, attending FREE summer school is a privilege, not a right! Not participating or doing your work will be considered a discipline problem. Misbehavior may result in removal from summer school with no credit. More than two (2) absences will result in loss of credit. Students who register late (after June 4, 2007) will not be allowed to miss any days.
