In English II the student will integrate the language arts skills of speaking, listening, writing, and reading through the study of literature themes. Through an integrated approach to the study of composition, literature, and usage, the students will gain a better understanding of themselves and their relationships with others.

SUPPLIES:

1. black or blue pen, red pen, highlighters
2. 3 ring notebook (any color) with loose leaf paper
3. 5 dividers labeled as follows:
 - a. Grade Sheet
 - b. Warm-Up
 - c. Grammar
 - d. Literature
 - e. Strategies
4. 3X5 index cards (2nd semester)
5. Textbooks: Elements of Language, Language of Literature, and Vocabulary for the College Bound

CLASS RULES: *Failure to comply with class rules will result in conduct cut.

LATE WORK:

Late work will be accepted 1 class day (not school day) late, but the highest possible grade awarded will be a 70. An assignment turned in anytime after 1 class day will be awarded a zero.
