

RANGERETTE AUDITION

Eligibility Criteria

- ☆ A parent/guardian must attend the mandatory informational meeting. (The applicant need not be present, but it is highly recommended.)
- ☆ All application pages must be turned in by the designated date and time. Late applications will not be accepted. All pages must bear the parent/guardian's signature, as well as the applicant's signature.
- ☆ A copy of the most recent report card must be submitted with the signed application pages.
- ☆ Must have faculty evaluations completed and turned in to Mrs. Wilson's box by the designated deadline.
- ☆ Must be in grades 9-11 at the time of try outs.
- ☆ The applicant cannot have more than 1 failing grade in all subjects at the end of the fall semester.
- ☆ The applicant must not have more than 1 "P" or "U" in conduct during the year of try outs.

Each applicant and his/her parent/guardian must be fully aware of the large time and financial commitment. They must be aware of all other requirements and guidelines that the applicant must abide by if selected to be on the team. A signed application is the acknowledgement and agreement to abide by the rules and guidelines set forth.

There will be a mandatory try out clinic for 3 days before the audition. Each candidate will audition in small groups in front of a panel of judges who are considered to be specialists in the field of dance and drill team. The judges' decision is final.

Rangerettes is a year long commitment. If selected, the candidate and the parent/guardian is agreeing to participate and meet all requirements in full for the entire year.
