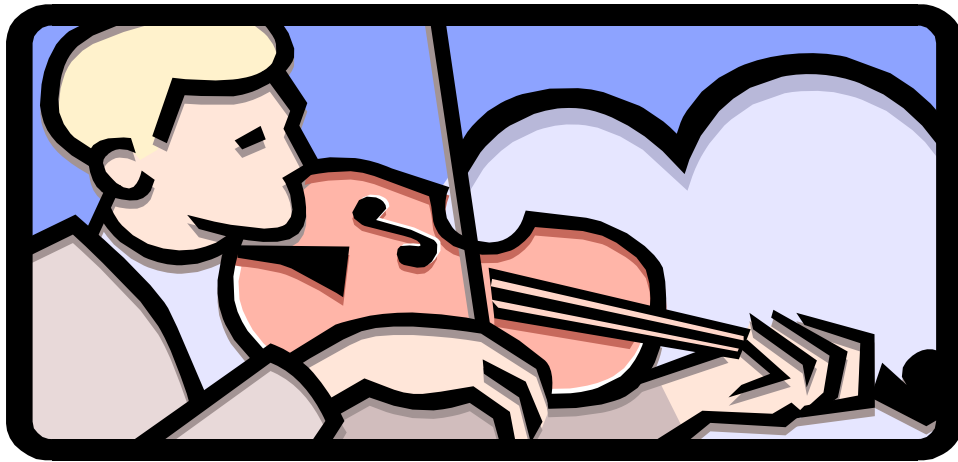

This is not a part of Senior Dues. You may purchase any items you choose, or you do not have to purchase anything at all.

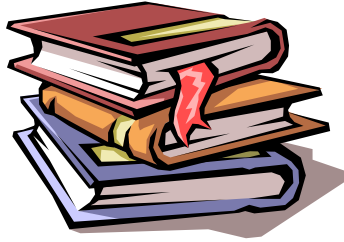
Class Rings can also be ordered during your senior year.

From the Registrar

When will ranks and GPA's be issued?

Preliminary ranks and GPA's will be available during lunch on Friday, October 9th from Ms. Lewis. This **IS NOT** official, but you may use it for college applications and scholarships. You may also pick up an unofficial transcript at that time. Official Ranks and GPA's will be issued in January after the first semester's grades are added.

How do I request a transcript?

Come to Ms. Lewis's office, fill out the form, pick it up the next day.

What is the difference in an official transcript and an unofficial transcript?

An *official transcript* is mailed by the Registrar or the college coordinator. An *unofficial transcript* can be given to the student or parent.

Is there a charge for transcripts?

There is never a charge for transcripts that are mailed with scholarship applications. There is a \$1 charge for all other transcripts after the first 3.

How do I apply to a college? Apply for a scholarship? Take the SAT?ACT?

See your College Access Coordinator, Ms. Cozart.

How do I get information about playing college sports?

See your Play it Smart Academic Coordinator, Ms. Cameron.

How do I find out how many credits I have or need to graduate?

See your counselor, Ms. Jackson or Ms. Blake.

Will you be a "Graduating" Senior?

Credits: You must have 18 credits to be classified as a senior.

You must have 24 credits to graduate, which must include the following credits:

English	4.0	Speech	.5
Math	3.0	PE	1.5
Science	3.0	Health	.5
History	3.0	For Lang	1.0 (2.0 for Texas Scholars)
Govt	.5	Fine Arts	1.0 (for Texas Scholars)
Eco	.5	Electives	5.5 (3.5 for Texas Scholars)
Computer	1.0		

TAKS: You must pass or be exempt from All Parts of TAKS. If you have not passed, TAKS will be given in October and again in April to all potential graduates.

Asterisks: See your counselor for information on clearing.

Failed Classes: You may attend Credit Recovery to make up credits for classes you have failed. See Credit Recovery Schedule.

Attendance: Excessive absences will cause you to lose credit for courses and/or be withdrawn from school if you are 18 yrs old.

Discipline: Suspensions cause loss of class time which may result in failure of classes.

If you feel you are in jeopardy of not graduating because of one or more of the above, you and your parents should talk to your counselor today for help or alternatives!
