The meeting was called to order at 3:45. The first order of business was the list of meetings for the remainder of the year. Mr. Siebenaler indicated that some of our “systems” need adjusting. The members compiled a list of “systems” for consideration which included the following:

1. Tardies
2. Rearranging the bell schedule or adjusting tutorial so that lunches are not so late.
3. Having translators available for all public meetings
4. Dress Code enforcement
5. Food outside of the cafeteria areas
6. Healthy Snacks machine
7. Students roaming during lunches
8. Locker integrity
9. Childcare hallway

11. Building Use fees – we are unable to attain objectives because of outside building use fees not being paid
12. Reduction of tutorial class sizes
13. National Honor Society students earning volunteer hours serving as tutors during tutorial periods
14. Failure to communicate effectively
15. School Spirit

Mr. Lertora presented a Tardy Plan for consideration. The following suggestions were made:

- Loss of privilege has already occurred prior to the sixth tardy
- More work on the front end will help later on
- Hold drawings for prizes for students with clean tardy slips
- Monitoring occurs when teachers have to sign a student’s tardy slip. When a teacher signs the sixth spot, he or she then turns the slip in to the office.
- Perhaps the loss of privilege comes too soon at the current level.
- Start playing music one minute before the bell rings as a warning.

Mr. Siebenaler stated that the proposals for changes will be submitted to SDMC on October 15, 2003, then the faculty on the 20<sup>th</sup> and the community thereafter. We will begin systematic changes on the identified issues.
